PGU Ranking – Category Super

1. Eligibility:

As per the General Conditions of Play – GMS 2018, clause 2. a), men with HCP 15.0 or lower, women with HCP 21. or lower.

a) Ladies and men – born in 1967 or earlier.

2. Qualification, fees and entries:

a) The maximum field for the Tournament shall be 108 players including players granted “Wild Cards”.

b) Entries will be accepted through the www.polishchampionships.pl website up to **18 May 2018**.

c) Qualification for the Tournament will be by HCP value with the reservation of clause 4. of the General Conditions of Play – GMS 2018. The PGU Board reserves the right to grant 6 “Wild Cards” for the Tournament.

d) **The entry fee is 360 PLN and is accepted by 18 May, 2018.**

3. Confirmation or resignation from participation:

a) A player is obliged to confirm the participation till 3 p.m. on 31 May 2018. In case of a lack of confirmation, the entry fee shall not be returned.

b) A player can confirm his or her participation:

- by phone at the number: + 48 501-568-459 lub 726-159-697 from 10 am till 5 pm on 29 and 30 May 2018 and from 10 am till 3 pm on 31 May 2018
- in person on the training day from 10 a.m. till 3 p.m. at the Tournament Office.

- c) Resignation from the participation should be done according to clause 5. of the General Conditions of Play – GMS 2018.
- d) A player not associated in PGU, who starts in the tournament, is obliged to submit a certificate issued by a national union/federation, confirming his or her current HCP, in a paper version to the Tournament Office or by email to organizacja@pzgolf.pl, latest till 3 p.m. **on the 31 May 2018**. A person who fails to do this, can not take part in the tournament.

4. Format of play; tees; classification:

- a) The format shall be Stroke Play over 54 holes, (3 rounds per 18 holes):
 - **1 June – round I**
 - **2 June – round II**
 - **CUT – as per General Conditions of Play – GMS 2018, clause 12.**
 - **3 June – round III (final)**
- b) **PGU Tournament tee:**
 - Course length for Men – **5654 metres (yellow)** – including distance changes allowed by the EGA.
 - Course length for Ladies – **5047 metres (red)** – including distance changes allowed by the EGA.
- c) Ties – as per GMS 2018 General Conditions of Play, clause 13.

5. Winners:

- a) Winners in the stroke play gross Open classification receive the following titles:
 - I place - Polish Senior Champion
 - II place - I Polish Senior Vice-Champion
 - III place - II Polish Senior Vice-Champion
 - I place - Polish Senior Lady Champion
 - II place - I Polish Senior Lady Vice-Champion
 - III place - II Polish Senior Lady Vice-Champion
- b) Winners in the stroke play gross Masters classification (players born in 1952 or earlier) receive the following titles:
 - I place - Polish Master Senior Champion
 - II place - I Polish Master Senior Vice-Champion
 - III place - II Polish Master Senior Vice-Champion
 - I place - Polish Master Senior Lady Champion
 - II place - I Polish Master Senior Lady Vice-Champion
 - III place - II Polish Master Senior Lady Vice-Champion
- c) Trophies in Masters classification will be given if at least 5 players in this category will attend the tournament.

- d) Trophies in the stroke play net general classification as per General Conditions of Play 2018, clauses 14-16.

6. PGU Ranking:

Ranking points will be given to the PGU Members as per the PGU 2018 Ranking Conditions.
